Good Earth Community Garden 2018 PLOT APPLICATION

Good Earth Community Garden is a satellite garden of the South Coast Community Garden Association located at the end of 8th Court St and Franklin. Plots are rented on a first come first served basis for \$20. \$10 may be refunded at the gardener's request **IF** the plot is well maintained, harvested frequently, and cleaned at season's end. If plots are full, you will be placed on a waiting list. One plot is allowed per household, family or organization. Exceptions can be made if beds remain open in June. Renters of Good Earth Community Garden must also become members of the South Coast Community Garden Association (SCCGA). You must also complete the SCCGA Membership application (attached) and pay the annual \$10 Membership Dues. **PLEASE write ONE check to SCCGA.**

Anyone 18 years or older may apply for SCCGA Membership and to use a plot at Good Earth. Fee waivers are available.

To participate you must do the following:

1. Complete the SCCGA Membership Application (\$10 per membership)
2. Complete the Good Earth Community Garden Plot Application (\$20/\$10 refundable)
3. Send **BOTH** applications and **ONE** check in the amount of \$30 to:
